Definition: a building for living in

Example: They live in a beautiful house near the park.

home (noun)

Definition: a place where one lives

Example: Home is where the heart is.

room (noun)

Definition: a space within a building

Example: My bedroom is small but comfortable.

apartment (noun)

Definition: a self-contained dwelling

Example: She rents an apartment downtown.

door (noun)

Definition: an opening for entering/exiting

Example: Please close the door behind you.

window (noun)

Definition: an opening to see outside

Example: The window provides natural light.

wall (noun)

Definition: a vertical structure

Example: The wall needs fresh paint.

ceiling (noun)

Definition: the upper surface of a room

Example: The ceiling is very high.

floor (noun)

Definition: the bottom surface of a room

Example: The kitchen floor is clean.

bed (noun)

Definition: furniture for sleeping

Example: I make my bed every morning.

sofa (noun)

Definition: a long seat

Example: Come sit with me on the sofa.

chair (noun)

Definition: a seat with a back

Example: Sit down on the chair and relax.

table (noun)

Definition: a flat surface with legs

Example: We eat dinner at the table.

desk (noun)

Definition: a work table

Example: Keep your desk organized.

lamp (noun)

Definition: a device that produces light

Example: Turn on the lamp to read.

light (noun)

Definition: illumination

Example: Turn on the light in the hallway.

switch (noun)

Definition: a control for electricity

Example: The light switch is by the door.

furniture (noun)

Definition: movable objects for use

Example: The furniture is modern.

cabinet (noun)

Definition: a cupboard with doors

Example: Store dishes in the cabinet.

shelf (noun)

Definition: a flat surface attached to wall

Example: I put books on the shelf.

drawer (noun)

Definition: a box that slides out

Example: Keep socks in the drawer.

closet (noun)

Definition: a small room for storage

Example: Hang your coat in the closet.

mirror (noun)

Definition: a reflective surface

Example: Look at yourself in the mirror.

picture (noun)

Definition: a visual image

Example: There's a picture on the wall.

carpet (noun)

Definition: a thick floor covering

Example: The carpet in the bedroom is soft.

curtain (noun)

Definition: fabric hanging at a window

Example: Close the curtains before sleeping.

pillow (noun)

Definition: a cushion for the head

Example: My pillow is very comfortable.

blanket (noun)

Definition: a covering for warmth

Example: I need another blanket.

sheet (noun)

Definition: a piece of cloth for bed

Example: Change the sheets weekly.

towel (noun)

Definition: cloth for drying

Example: Get a towel from the bathroom.

kitchen (noun)

Definition: a room for cooking

Example: I cook breakfast in the kitchen.

bathroom (noun)

Definition: a room with bath/toilet

Example: The bathroom needs new tiles.

bedroom (noun)

Definition: a room for sleeping

Example: My bedroom is upstairs.

living room (noun)

Definition: a room for relaxing

Example: We watch TV in the living room.

dining room (noun)

Definition: a room for eating

Example: Dinner is in the dining room.

hallway (noun)

Definition: a passage between rooms

Example: The hallway is wide.

staircase (noun)

Definition: steps for going up/down

Example: Use the staircase carefully.

stairs (noun)

Definition: steps for going up/down

Example: Be careful on the stairs.

basement (noun)

Definition: the lowest level

Example: The basement has storage.

attic (noun)

Definition: a space under the roof

Example: We keep boxes in the attic.

garage (noun)

Definition: a building for cars

Example: Park your car in the garage.

yard (noun)

Definition: outdoor area around house

Example: The kids play in the yard.

garden (noun)

Definition: an area for growing plants

Example: I grow vegetables in my garden.

porch (noun)

Definition: a covered entrance

Example: Sit on the porch in evening.

patio (noun)

Definition: an outdoor area

Example: We barbecue on the patio.

driveway (noun)

Definition: a road to a building

Example: The driveway is long.

fence (noun)

Definition: a barrier around property

Example: The fence surrounds the yard.

gate (noun)

Definition: an entrance to area

Example: Open the gate to enter.

key (noun)

Definition: a device to open lock

Example: I found my house key.

lock (noun)

Definition: a device to secure

Example: The door lock is broken.

doorbell (noun)

Definition: a button making sound

Example: Ring the doorbell when arriving.

handle (noun)

Definition: a grip for holding

Example: Turn the handle to open door.

hinge (noun)

Definition: a moving joint

Example: The door hinge is loose.

bolt (noun)

Definition: a fastener

Example: Bolt the door from inside.

nail (noun)

Definition: a pointed fastener

Example: Use a nail to hang picture.

screw (noun)

Definition: a twisted fastener

Example: Tighten the screw.

hammer (noun)

Definition: a tool for hitting

Example: Use a hammer to drive nail.

screwdriver (noun)

Definition: a tool for screws

Example: I need a screwdriver.

ladder (noun)

Definition: steps for climbing

Example: Get the ladder to reach ceiling.

step (noun)

Definition: a stair

Example: Mind the step when entering.

roof (noun)

Definition: top covering of building

Example: The roof needs repair.

brick (noun)

Definition: a building block

Example: The house is made of brick.

concrete (noun)

Definition: a hard building material

Example: The driveway is concrete.

wood (noun)

Definition: material from trees

Example: The table is made of wood.

stone (noun)

Definition: hard rock material

Example: The wall is made of stone.

glass (noun)

Definition: transparent material

Example: The window is glass.

metal (noun)

Definition: a hard shiny material

Example: The door handle is metal.

paint (noun/verb)

Definition: coloring substance

Example: Paint the walls blue.

wallpaper (noun)

Definition: decorative wall covering

Example: The wallpaper is beautiful.

tile (noun)

Definition: a flat piece for covering

Example: The bathroom has new tiles.

corner (noun)

Definition: where two lines meet

Example: The furniture is in corner.

center (noun)

Definition: the middle point

Example: Put the lamp in center.

side (noun)

Definition: a surface or edge

Example: Park on the side of road.

front (noun)

Definition: the forward part

Example: Front of house faces street.

back (noun)

Definition: the rear part

Example: Garden is in the back.

top (noun)

Definition: the highest point

Example: Put book on top of shelf.

bottom (noun)

Definition: the lowest point

Example: Item is at bottom of box.

inside (noun/adverb)

Definition: the interior

Example: Go inside the house.

outside (noun/adverb)

Definition: the exterior

Example: Let's play outside.

upstairs (adverb)

Definition: on a higher floor

Example: Bedrooms are upstairs.

downstairs (adverb)

Definition: on a lower floor

Example: Kitchen is downstairs.

left (adjective)

Definition: opposite of right

Example: Turn left at corner.

right (adjective)

Definition: one direction

Example: Bathroom is on right.

straight (adverb)

Definition: in a direct line

Example: Go straight ahead.

around (preposition)

Definition: encircling

Example: Fence goes around property.

through (preposition)

Definition: from one side to other

Example: Walk through the door.

across (preposition)

Definition: from one side to other

Example: Street is across the road.

near (preposition)

Definition: close to

Example: House is near the lake.

far (adjective)

Definition: at great distance

Example: Store is far from here.

close (adjective)

Definition: near

Example: School is close to house.

high (adjective)

Definition: tall

Example: Ceiling is very high.

low (adjective)

Definition: short

Example: The table is low.

wide (adjective)

Definition: broad

Example: The hallway is wide.

narrow (adjective)

Definition: not wide

Example: The hallway is narrow.

long (adjective)

Definition: extended in length

Example: The corridor is long.

short (adjective)

Definition: not long

Example: The hallway is short.

big (adjective)

Definition: large

Example: We have a big house.

small (adjective)

Definition: little

Example: The closet is small.

clean (adjective)

Definition: free from dirt

Example: Keep room clean.

dirty (adjective)

Definition: not clean

Example: The floor is dirty.

neat (adjective)

Definition: tidy

Example: Your desk should be neat.

messy (adjective)

Definition: untidy

Example: Don't leave room messy.

bright (adjective)

Definition: full of light

Example: Living room is bright.

dark (adjective)

Definition: without light

Example: Basement is dark.

warm (adjective)

Definition: having heat

Example: *House is warm in winter.*

cold (adjective)

Definition: lacking heat

Example: *Room is cold without heater.*

comfortable (adjective)

Definition: providing ease

Example: *The bed is comfortable.*

cozy (adjective)

Definition: warm and snug

Example: *The room is cozy.*

Food & Eating

food (noun)

Definition: something eaten for nutrition

Example: Healthy food keeps us strong.

eat (verb)

Definition: to consume food

Example: We eat breakfast at 7 AM.

drink (verb)

Definition: to consume liquid

Example: Drink water throughout day.

meal (noun)

Definition: an instance of eating

Example: Dinner is my favorite meal.

breakfast (noun)

Definition: the first meal of day

Example: Breakfast should be nutritious.

lunch (noun)

Definition: the midday meal

Example: I eat lunch at noon.

dinner (noun)

Definition: the evening meal

Example: We have dinner at 6 PM.

snack (noun)

Definition: a small amount of food

Example: Eat a snack if hungry.

appetizer (noun)

Definition: first course

Example: Start with an appetizer.

dessert (noun)

Definition: a sweet course

Example: What's for dessert?

fruit (noun)

Definition: a sweet plant product

Example: Apples are my favorite fruit.

apple (noun)

Definition: a round fruit

Example: An apple a day keeps doctor away.

banana (noun)

Definition: a yellow fruit

Example: Bananas are rich in potassium.

orange (noun)

Definition: a citrus fruit

Example: Orange juice is refreshing.

grape (noun)

Definition: a small fruit

Example: Grapes come in bunches.

strawberry (noun)

Definition: a red berries

Example: Strawberries are sweet.

watermelon (noun)

Definition: a large fruit

Example: Watermelon is refreshing summer.

vegetable (noun)

Definition: an edible plant

Example: Eat more vegetables for health.

carrot (noun)

Definition: an orange vegetable

Example: Carrots improve eyesight.

broccoli (noun)

Definition: a green vegetable

Example: Broccoli is nutritious.

tomato (noun)

Definition: a red vegetable

Example: Add tomato to salad.

potato (noun)

Definition: a starchy vegetable

Example: Boil the potato.

onion (noun)

Definition: a pungent vegetable

Example: Chop the onion finely.

lettuce (noun)

Definition: a leafy vegetable

Example: Add lettuce to sandwich.

cucumber (noun)

Definition: a green vegetable

Example: Slice the cucumber.

spinach (noun)

Definition: a green leafy vegetable

Example: Spinach is very healthy.

pepper (noun)

Definition: a vegetable or spice

Example: Add red pepper to dish.

bread (noun)

Definition: a staple food from grain

Example: Toast the bread for breakfast.

rice (noun)

Definition: a grain staple

Example: Rice is popular in Asia.

pasta (noun)

Definition: a flour-based food

Example: I cook pasta twice weekly.

noodle (noun)

Definition: a thin strand food

Example: Eat noodles with fork.

cereal (noun)

Definition: a grain food

Example: Have cereal for breakfast.

oatmeal (noun)

Definition: a grain porridge

Example: Oatmeal is healthy breakfast.

meat (noun)

Definition: animal flesh as food

Example: Chicken is lean meat.

chicken (noun)

Definition: poultry

Example: Grilled chicken is healthy.

beef (noun)

Definition: meat from cattle

Example: Beef is rich in protein.

pork (noun)

Definition: meat from pig

Example: Pork chops are delicious.

fish (noun)

Definition: aquatic animal meat

Example: Fish is good for heart.

salmon (noun)

Definition: a type of fish

Example: Salmon is rich in omega-3.

shrimp (noun)

Definition: a small seafood

Example: Shrimp is tasty.

egg (noun)

Definition: an oval object from birds

Example: Boil an egg for breakfast.

cheese (noun)

Definition: a dairy product

Example: Add cheese to pasta.

milk (noun)

Definition: white liquid from mammals

Example: Drink milk for strong bones.

yogurt (noun)

Definition: a fermented dairy product

Example: Yogurt is healthy snack.

butter (noun)

Definition: a dairy fat

Example: Spread butter on bread.

cream (noun)

Definition: thick dairy product

Example: Add cream to coffee.

ice cream (noun)

Definition: a frozen sweet treat

Example: Vanilla ice cream is classic.

chocolate (noun)

Definition: a sweet brown confection

Example: I love chocolate cake.

candy (noun)

Definition: a sweet confection

Example: Don't eat too much candy.

cookie (noun)

Definition: a small sweet treat

Example: Chocolate cookies are favorite.

cake (noun)

Definition: a baked sweet dessert

Example: Cut a slice of cake.

pie (noun)

Definition: a baked dish with filling

Example: Apple pie is delicious.

sandwich (noun)

Definition: food between bread

Example: I make sandwich for lunch.

hamburger (noun)

Definition: a meat sandwich

Example: The hamburger is juicy.

pizza (noun)

Definition: a baked dish with toppings

Example: Pepperoni pizza is delicious.

soup (noun)

Definition: a liquid food

Example: Tomato soup is warming.

salad (noun)

Definition: a dish of raw vegetables

Example: Make a fresh salad for lunch.

oil (noun)

Definition: a liquid fat

Example: Cook with olive oil.

salt (noun)

Definition: a seasoning mineral

Example: Add a pinch of salt.

sugar (noun)

Definition: a sweet substance

Example: Coffee tastes better with sugar.

spice (noun)

Definition: a seasoning from plants

Example: Use spices to flavor food.

pepper (noun)

Definition: a spicy seasoning

Example: Add black pepper to taste.

sauce (noun)

Definition: a liquid dressing

Example: Pour sauce over the meat.

butter (noun)

Definition: a dairy spread

Example: Butter makes food rich.

juice (noun)

Definition: liquid from fruits

Example: Orange juice is refreshing.

coffee (noun)

Definition: a hot beverage from beans

Example: I drink coffee every morning.

tea (noun)

Definition: a hot beverage from leaves

Example: Green tea is healthy.

water (noun)

Definition: a clear liquid

Example: Drink plenty of water daily.

soda (noun)

Definition: a carbonated drink

Example: Soda contains lots of sugar.

beer (noun)

Definition: an alcoholic beverage

Example: Beer is popular in countries.

wine (noun)

Definition: an alcoholic drink from grapes

Example: Red wine tastes wonderful.

plate (noun)

Definition: a flat dish for serving

Example: Put food on the plate.

bowl (noun)

Definition: a round dish

Example: Soup goes in a bowl.

cup (noun)

Definition: a drinking vessel

Example: Coffee goes in a cup.

glass (noun)

Definition: a transparent vessel

Example: Fill the glass with water.

mug (noun)

Definition: a large cup

Example: My coffee mug is warm.

spoon (noun)

Definition: an eating utensil

Example: Use a spoon for soup.

fork (noun)

Definition: an eating utensil

Example: Eat salad with a fork.

knife (noun)

Definition: a cutting utensil

Example: Use a knife to cut meat.

pot (noun)

Definition: a container for cooking

Example: Boil water in the pot.

pan (noun)

Definition: a cooking vessel

Example: Fry eggs in the pan.

oven (noun)

Definition: an appliance for baking

Example: Bake the cake in oven.

stove (noun)

Definition: an appliance for cooking

Example: Cook dinner on the stove.

refrigerator (noun)

Definition: a cold storage appliance

Example: Keep milk in refrigerator.

freezer (noun)

Definition: a very cold storage

Example: Store ice cream in freezer.

sink (noun)

Definition: a basin for washing

Example: Wash dishes in the sink.

cook (verb)

Definition: to prepare food with heat

Example: Cook chicken for 20 minutes.

bake (verb)

Definition: to cook in an oven

Example: Bake cookies at 350 degrees.

boil (verb)

Definition: to heat to boiling point

Example: Boil water for tea.

fry (verb)

Definition: to cook in hot oil

Example: Fry eggs in butter.

grill (verb)

Definition: to cook over fire

Example: Grill steak for dinner.

roast (verb)

Definition: to cook with dry heat

Example: Roast chicken in oven.

taste (verb)

Definition: to eat a small amount

Example: Taste soup to check flavor.

chew (verb)

Definition: to bite and grind

Example: Chew your food well.

swallow (verb)

Definition: to pass food down throat

Example: Swallow before speaking.

hungry (adjective)

Definition: wanting to eat

Example: I'm hungry after exercise.

full (adjective)

Definition: having eaten enough

Example: I'm too full to eat dessert.

delicious (adjective)

Definition: tasting very good

Example: The meal was delicious.

tasty (adjective)

Definition: having pleasant flavor

Example: The food is tasty.

sweet (adjective)

Definition: having sugar taste

Example: This apple is very sweet.

salty (adjective)

Definition: containing salt

Example: The soup is too salty.

sour (adjective)

Definition: having acid taste

Example: Lemon juice is sour.

bitter (adjective)

Definition: having unpleasant taste

Example: Dark chocolate can be bitter.

spicy (adjective)

Definition: having hot pepper taste

Example: Curry is very spicy.

Travel & Transportation

travel (verb)

Definition: to go from one place to another

Example: I love to travel around world.

trip (noun)

Definition: a journey

Example: My trip to Japan was amazing.

journey (noun)

Definition: a travel experience

Example: The journey took three hours.

vacation (noun)

Definition: time away from work

Example: We took vacation in summer.

visit (verb)

Definition: to go see someone/place

Example: I visit grandmother every month.

tour (noun)

Definition: a guided journey

Example: Join our city tour tomorrow.

flight (noun)

Definition: travel by airplane

Example: The flight was delayed.

airplane (noun)

Definition: a flying vehicle

Example: The airplane landed safely.

plane (noun)

Definition: short for airplane

Example: I'm taking the 6 PM plane.

airport (noun)

Definition: a place for airplanes

Example: I'll meet you at airport.

train (noun)

Definition: a rail vehicle

Example: The train departs at noon.

station (noun)

Definition: a stop for transport

Example: The train station is busy.

bus (noun)

Definition: a large transport vehicle

Example: Take the bus to downtown.

car (noun)

Definition: a motor vehicle

Example: My car needs new tires.

taxi (noun)

Definition: a hired vehicle

Example: Call a taxi to go hotel.

bike (noun)

Definition: a bicycle or motorcycle

Example: Ride your bike to work.

bicycle (noun)

Definition: a pedal-powered vehicle

Example: I ride bicycle on weekends.

motorcycle (noun)

Definition: a motorized bike

Example: He rides a motorcycle.

boat (noun)

Definition: a water vessel

Example: Take a boat across river.

ship (noun)

Definition: a large boat

Example: The ship travels the seas.

ferry (noun)

Definition: a boat for short routes

Example: Take ferry across the bay.

cruise (noun)

Definition: a pleasure boat journey

Example: They took cruise vacation.

helicopter (noun)

Definition: an aircraft with rotors

Example: The helicopter hovered above.

passenger (noun)

Definition: someone traveling

Example: The passenger sat in back.

driver (noun)

Definition: someone who drives

Example: The driver was very careful.

pilot (noun)

Definition: someone flying plane

Example: The pilot made announcement.

captain (noun)

Definition: a ship's leader

Example: The captain commanded crew.

ticket (noun)

Definition: a document for travel

Example: Buy ticket at the counter.

seat (noun)

Definition: a place to sit

Example: I have window seat.

luggage (noun)

Definition: bags for traveling

Example: Pack luggage carefully.

baggage (noun)

Definition: belongings for travel

Example: Check baggage limit.

suitcase (noun)

Definition: a rigid travel bag

Example: My suitcase is full.

backpack (noun)

Definition: a bag worn on back

Example: Put supplies in backpack.

passport (noun)

Definition: a document for travel

Example: Don't forget passport.

visa (noun)

Definition: a travel permission

Example: You need visa to enter.

currency (noun)

Definition: money of a country

Example: Exchange currency at bank.

map (noun)

Definition: a guide to places

Example: Consult map for directions.

destination (noun)

Definition: where you're going

Example: Our destination is Paris.

route (noun)

Definition: a path or way

Example: The route takes two hours.

direction (noun)

Definition: which way to go

Example: Go in that direction.

north (noun)

Definition: a cardinal direction

Example: The city is north of here.

south (noun)

Definition: a cardinal direction

Example: Travel south along coast.

east (noun)

Definition: a cardinal direction

Example: The beach is east of town.

west (noun)

Definition: a cardinal direction

Example: Mountains are west of us.

left (noun/adjective)

Definition: one side

Example: Turn left at the light.

right (noun/adjective)

Definition: the other side

Example: Hotel is on right.

straight (adverb)

Definition: without turning

Example: Go straight ahead.

forward (adverb)

Definition: ahead

Example: Move forward slowly.

back (adverb)

Definition: in reverse

Example: Back up carefully.

stop (verb)

Definition: to cease motion

Example: Stop at red light.

start (verb)

Definition: to begin

Example: Start the engine.

depart (verb)

Definition: to leave

Example: Train departs at 3 PM.

arrive (verb)

Definition: to reach destination

Example: We arrive tomorrow morning.

leave (verb)

Definition: to go away

Example: Leave at 7 AM.

return (verb)

Definition: to come back

Example: I return home on Friday.

speed (noun)

Definition: how fast

Example: Speed limit is 50 mph.

slow (verb/adjective)

Definition: reduce pace

Example: Slow down near school.

fast (adjective)

Definition: quick

Example: Fast train is here.

parking (noun)

Definition: a place to park

Example: Find parking nearby.

garage (noun)

Definition: a building for cars

Example: Park car in garage.

gas station (noun)

Definition: a fuel stop

Example: Stop at gas station.

road (noun)

Definition: a surface for driving

Example: Road is busy today.

street (noun)

Definition: a paved way in town

Example: My apartment is on Main Street.

highway (noun)

Definition: a major road

Example: Highway is congested.

lane (noun)

Definition: a division of road

Example: Change lanes carefully.

corner (noun)

Definition: where paths meet

Example: Turn at corner.

intersection (noun)

Definition: where roads cross

Example: Intersection is busy.

bridge (noun)

Definition: a structure over gap

Example: Cross bridge carefully.

tunnel (noun)

Definition: a passage underground

Example: Tunnel is dark.

mountain (noun)

Definition: a high landform

Example: Mountain is beautiful.

valley (noun)

Definition: a low area

Example: Town sits in valley.

river (noun)

Definition: flowing water

Example: River runs through town.

ocean (noun)

Definition: large salt water

Example: Ocean is vast.

beach (noun)

Definition: sandy shore

Example: Beach is crowded today.

coast (noun)

Definition: land by ocean

Example: Coast is scenic.

island (noun)

Definition: land surrounded by water

Example: Island has palm trees.

port (noun)

Definition: a harboring place

Example: Ships dock at port.

dock (noun)

Definition: a structure for boats

Example: Boat is at dock.

terminal (noun)

Definition: an endpoint

Example: Bus terminal is busy.

gate (noun)

Definition: an entrance

Example: Security check at gate.

counter (noun)

Definition: a service desk

Example: Buy tickets at counter.

entrance (noun)

Definition: a way in

Example: Entrance is on left.

exit (noun)

Definition: a way out

Example: Exit is ahead.

hotel (noun)

Definition: a lodging place

Example: Book hotel room online.

motel (noun)

Definition: a simple hotel

Example: Motel is budget-friendly.

inn (noun)

Definition: a small hotel

Example: Stay at cozy inn.

hostel (noun)

Definition: budget lodging

Example: Hostel is great for backpackers.

room (noun)

Definition: a space to stay

Example: Reserve room for two nights.

bed (noun)

Definition: sleeping furniture

Example: Bed is comfortable.

check-in (noun)

Definition: arrival at hotel

Example: Check-in is at 3 PM.

check-out (noun)

Definition: departure from hotel

Example: Check-out time is 11 AM.

reservation (noun)

Definition: a booking

Example: I made reservation for tonight.

tour guide (noun)

Definition: a travel guide person

Example: Tour guide is knowledgeable.

souvenir (noun)

Definition: a travel memento

Example: Buy souvenir from trip.

delay (noun)

Definition: a wait

Example: Flight had delay.

schedule (noun)

Definition: a time plan

Example: Check bus schedule.

timetable (noun)

Definition: arrival/departure times

Example: Timetable is on wall.

ontime (adverb)

Definition: punctual

Example: Train running ontime.

late (adjective)

Definition: after expected time

Example: Bus is late.

early (adjective)

Definition: before expected time

Example: We arrived early for flight.

distance (noun)

Definition: space between places

Example: What's distance to city.

Business & Work

work (noun/verb)

Definition: a payment card

Example: Paid with credit card.

debit card (noun)

Definition: a bank card

Example: Use debit card.

bank card (noun)

Definition: a financial card

Example: Lost bank card.

check (noun)

Definition: a payment instrument

Example: Pay by check.

cheque (noun)

Definition: British spelling of check

Example: Write cheque.

transaction (noun)

Definition: a business exchange

Example: Transaction complete.

purchase (noun)

Definition: a buy

Example: Purchase is recorded.

order (noun)

Definition: a request to buy

Example: Place order today.

delivery (noun)

Definition: bringing goods

Example: Delivery is tomorrow.

shipment (noun)

Definition: goods being transported

Example: Shipment arrived.

return (noun/verb)

Definition: sending back goods

Example: Return is free.

exchange (noun/verb)

Definition: swapping goods

Example: Exchange is allowed.

warranty (noun)

Definition: a guarantee

Example: Warranty is included.

guarantee (noun)

Definition: a promise

Example: Guarantee is strong.

refund (noun/verb)

Definition: money returned

Example: Refund is quick.

money back (noun)

Definition: reimbursement

Example: Money back promised.

tax (noun)

Definition: a government fee

Example: Tax is calculated.

sales tax (noun)

Definition: tax on sale

Example: Sales tax added.

discount (noun)

Definition: a reduction

Example: Discount is applied.

coupon (noun)

Definition: a discount ticket

Example: Use coupon here.

gift card (noun)

Definition: a stored value card

Example: Gift card redeemed.

receipt (noun)

Definition: a purchase record

Example: Keep receipt.

invoice (noun)

Definition: a bill

Example: Send invoice.

bill (noun)

Definition: a statement of charges

Example: Bill is due.

account (noun)

Definition: a record

Example: Account is active.

balance (noun)

Definition: the amount

Example: Balance is positive.

debt (noun)

Definition: money owed

Example: Debt is manageable.

credit (noun)

Definition: borrowed money

Example: Credit is available.

interest (noun)

Definition: fee for borrowing

Example: Interest is 5%.

loan (noun)

Definition: borrowed money

Example: Loan is approved.

mortgage (noun)

Definition: a property loan

Example: Mortgage rate dropped.

insurance (noun)

Definition: financial protection

Example: Insurance is wise.

investment (noun)

Definition: money placed for return

Example: Investment pays off.

stock (noun)

Definition: ownership share

Example: Stock price rises.

bond (noun)

Definition: a debt instrument

Example: Bond yield increases.

profit (noun)

Definition: money gained

Example: Profit is good.

loss (noun)

Definition: money lost

Example: Loss is significant.

income (noun)

Definition: money earned

Example: Income is stable.

savings (noun)

Definition: accumulated money

Example: Savings grows.

budget (noun)

Definition: a spending plan

Example: Budget is tight.

allowance (noun)

Definition: money given

Example: Allowance is increased.

tip (noun)

Definition: extra money given

Example: Tip is generous.

gratuity (noun)

Definition: a service charge

Example: Gratuity is included.

bribe (noun)

Definition: an illegal payment

Example: Bribe is unethical.

donation (noun)

Definition: a charitable gift

Example: Donation is appreciated.

charity (noun)

Definition: helping the poor

Example: Charity is noble.

free (adjective)

Definition: costing nothing

Example: Sample is free.

paid (adjective)

Definition: requiring payment

Example: Paid service offered.

open (adjective)

Definition: doing business

Example: Store is open.

closed (adjective)

Definition: not doing business

Example: Shop is closed.

convenient (adjective)

Definition: easy to access

Example: Location is convenient.

inconvenient (adjective)

Definition: hard to access

Example: Time is inconvenient.



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
